### **1.A. General**

#### **1.A. FLAG DISPLAY**

**Policy Reference: EL-1.6**

Regulations that govern the flying of the Canadian national flag are set forth in the Public Schools Act and by the Government of Canada.

Every school board shall erect and maintain upon the school building or on the school grounds a flagstaff and shall cause the national flag of Canada to be:

- a) flown on each day that the school is open, weather conditions permitting, or
- b) prominently displayed in the school building when weather conditions do not permit the flag to be flown outdoors;

Principals may lower the flag to half-mast during funerals of community members as a sign of respect.
