1.B. STUDENT ABSENCE

Under the Provisions of the *Public Schools Act*, every pupil between the ages of 7 and 18 must attend school. Principals of each school are responsible for keeping regular records of student attendance and reporting student absences in excess of 10% monthly to the Superintendent/CEO (as Truancy Officer). Lakeshore School Division is responsible to report attendance monthly to Manitoba Education, and to include reasons for student absences in excess of 10%.
